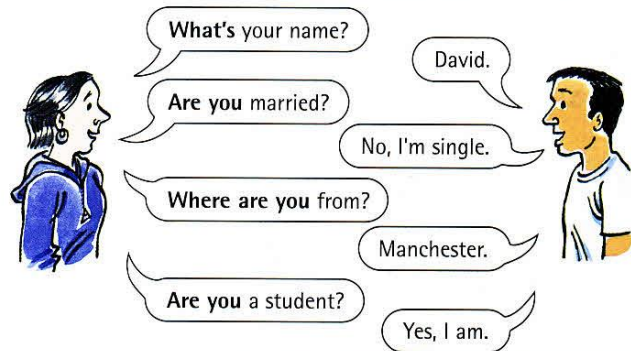

- 'Is it late?' 'No, **it's** only nine o'clock.' 'Est-ce qu'il est tard?' 'Non, il est ...'
- Your shoes are** nice. **Are they** new? Tes chaussures sont jolies. Sont-elles neuves?
