Quelle heure est-il s'il vous plaît?
Sauf dans les endroits comme les aéroports et les gares, les anglophones n'utilisent généralement pas l'horloge 24 heures

00h01-11h59: morning
12h00: midday
12h01-17h59: afternoon
18h00-23h59: evening
24h00: midnight

Donc on peut dire, par exemple:
It is midday ( 12 h 00 )
It is midnight ( 24 h 00 )

It is five o'clock in the morning ( 05 h 00 )
It is five o'clock in the afternoon ( 17 h 00 )

It is nine fifteen in the morning (09h15)
It is nine fifteen in the evening (21h15)

It is six twenty-five in the morning ( 06 h 25 )
It is six twenty-five in the evening (18h25)

En plus, il faut comprendre, par exemple:
It is ten (minutes) past six: $06 \mathrm{~h} 10 / 18 \mathrm{~h} 10$ It is a quarter past three: $03 \mathrm{~h} 15 / 15 \mathrm{~h} 15$ It is twenty (minutes) past one: $01 \mathrm{~h} 20 / 13 \mathrm{~h} 20$ It is half past seven: 07h30/19h30

It is twenty-five (minutes) to two: 01h35/13h35
It is a quarter to eleven: $10 \mathrm{~h} 45 / 22 \mathrm{~h} 45$
It is five (minutes) to eight: $07 \mathrm{~h} 55 / 19 \mathrm{~h} 55$

It is twelve o'clock ( $12 \mathrm{~h} 00 / 24 \mathrm{~h} 00$ )
It is seven o'clock ( $07 \mathrm{~h} 00 / 19 \mathrm{~h} 00$ )

It is eight thirty in the morning ( 08 h 30 )
It is eight thirty in the evening (20h30)

It is one forty-five in the morning (01h45)
It is one forty-five in the afternoon (13h45)

It is ten forty in the morning (10h40)
It is ten forty in the evening ( 22 h 40 )
