Maria didn't like the coffee (Henri)  
*Henri liked the coffee*

The children drank a glass of milk (I)

*I didn't drink a glass of milk*

We didn't eat breakfast (Henri)

*Henri ate breakfast*

They talked too much (She)

*She didn't talk too much*

I didn't like Fred (You)

*You liked Fred*

The president watched television last night (His minister)

*His minister didn't watch television last night*

You didn't play the piano very well (I)

*I played the piano very well*

He worked in a factory (We)

*We didn't work in a factory*

The students didn't do their homework in the library (You)

*You did your homework in the library*

We went to the cinema last Saturday (Maria)

*Maria didn't go to the cinema last Saturday*

Her son didn't travel by train (Her daughter)

*Her daughter travelled by train*

James came into the room (His brothers)

*His brothers didn't come into the room*

I didn't buy a newspaper yesterday (Rachel)

*Rachel bought a newspaper yesterday*

Henri wanted to be a doctor (You)

*You didn't want to be a doctor*

Kate didn't meet my friends yesterday (We)

*We met my friends yesterday*
